Author of the best-selling e Wine Bible, she is the recipient of every major wine award given in the English language, including the James Beard award for Wine and Spirits Professional of the Year, the Louis Roederer award for Best Consumer Wine Writing, and the International Wine and Spirits award as the Global Wine Communicator of the Year.

Hunter Drohojowska-Philp is an acclaimed American writer and lecturer on modern and contemporary art, architecture, and design. She has written several books, monographs, and essays, as well as non-fiction articles for the publications such as the Los Angeles Times, Architectural Digest, Wallpaper*, and e Times of London.
